



The upcoming Light Rail will connect Parramatta's CBD with Bankwest Stadium, the new Powerhouse Museum and cultural precinct, Westmead Health Precinct, Rosehill Gardens Racecourse and three Western Sydney University campuses – making this community even more connected as it thrives into the future.






It's all at your doorstep



Immerse yourself in a world of shopping, dining and entertainment – all at your doorstep. Westfield Parramatta is only 600 metres away, home to a range of local and international retailers, department stores, supermarkets and Event Cinemas. Nearby Eat Street is a foodie haven, where you have the widest selection of cuisine to indulge in from day to night.

You'll never be short of entertainment as a Parramatta local with culture, heritage and recreation at the core of the precinct's development. Whether it's a Parramatta Eels home game at Bankwest Stadium, a play at the Riverside Theatre or Spring Carnival at Rosehill Racecourse, you'll enjoy the vibrancy of life at the heart of Greater Sydney.

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IFFSTYLE

An urban playground

It's easy to step away from the city buzz, and immerse yourself in nature. Take the family for a picnic, kick the footy or explore endless cycleways and walking tracks in the 85 hectares of open green space that is Parramatta Park. With sporting fields, playgrounds and The Crescent natural amphitheatre for outdoor concerts and events, this has been the 'people's park' for more than 160 years. It also marks the site of Australia's first inland settlement, on the Burramattagal's traditional hunting grounds.

Parramatta River is another natural wonder to enjoy. Walking tracks and cycleways make it perfect for daily exercise, or bike along the 20km track from Parramatta to Sydney Olympic Park. Discover new bars and restaurants overlooking the river, with the Powerhouse Precinct set to open in 2023. Home to the new Museum of Arts and Applied Sciences, and revamped Riverside Theatre, it's the new cultural heart of Parramatta where you'll always find something new to explore.

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TRANSPORT & EDUCATION

A head start

As the geographical centre of greater Sydney, Parramatta is a hub of connectivity. Express trains can get you to the CBD in 30 minutes, while frequent bus services to the Hills District and Norwest Business Park provide plenty of options for a stress-free commute. For those who prefer to drive, upgrades to the M4 give you direct access to the city or further west to Penrith and the Blue Mountains. The planned Metro West line will make it even easier to connect with Sydney CBD, Homebush and Westmead.

Parramatta offers endless opportunities for lifelong learning, with a wide choice of public, private, independent schools and university campuses within easy reach. This includes NSW's first public high-rise high school Arthur Phillip High School in the CBD, the prestigious King's School and Tara Anglican School for Girls in North Parramatta and James Ruse Agricultural School in nearby Carlingford. And when it comes to taking the next step, Western Sydney University has campuses nearby, and its joint Engineering Innovation Hub with the University of NSW in the city centre will be completed in 2021.



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Parramatta is Sydney's second CBD and is benefiting from multi-billion dollar infrastructure projects that are improving transport connectivity, employment opportunities, education and entertainment.





GROWTH OPPORTUNITIES

A bright future

Parramatta's \$27 billion economy is the third largest in Australia, behind Sydney and Melbourne. It is a focal point for economic activity within NSW, and it's easy to see why investment continues to flow. A commitment to infrastructure makes Parramatta a convenient and well-connected location to work and live in.

Such a strong economy is good news for employment opportunities, with jobs growth in Parramatta outperforming the NSW average over the past three years. By 2036, the number of jobs within Parramatta's local government area is expected to almost double. With NAB, the Department of Education, Western Sydney University and University of NSW all making their move to Parramatta, the city's future potential is bright.1

The Westmead Health Precinct is Parramatta's largest employment sector, and it's only 3 minutes train ride from Parramatta's CBD. The NSW Government, universities and the private sector have committed a combined total of \$3.4billion over the next ten years to this precinct, which will also go towards expanding health, research and education facilities.

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


